Strengthening transparency of local institution through public information, promoting public participation on decision-making and increase the capacity of civil society in monitoring and addressing these issues

Implemented by: Woman to Woman Shkoder

Location: Municipality of Shkoder, Region of Shkoder

Duration: 12 months

Total budget: 22,898.40 Euro

Overall objective: Contribute on improving the quality of local democracy, by promoting transparency and citizen participation.

Specific objective: To strengthen the role of civil society in local government and fight against corruption, through information, participation on decision making and monitoring of local institutions.

Expected results:

- 1. Community of Shkodra Municipality sensitized about their right of information and participation in local decision making;
- 2. More active role of the community and civil society of Shkodra Municipality in policy influencing for social development.
- 3. Increased transparency and accountability of the local government institutions in regards to public information and participatory approach in decision-making.

Target groups: About 1,000 people (women, girls, boys and men) the community of the new Municipality of Shkodra; About 35 people--staff of Shkodra Municipality and coordinators of information and transparency in administrative units; 16 people (social observers) from non-governmental organizations, students and independent professional legal field.

Final beneficiaries: About 200 000 inhabitants of Shkodra Municipality.

Main activities:

- 1 Information and educational meetings on the rights to information and participation in decision making.
- 2 Workshops with focus groups of people from communities of 11 areas of Shkodra Municipality (R1, R2).
- 3 Set-up the group of experts (R2, R3).
- 4 Preparation of the monitoring process and monitoring forms by group of experts (R2, R3).
- 5 Build up and training of social observer group (R2, R3).
- 6 Monitoring process (R2, R3).
- 7 The monitoring report (R3).
- 8 Roundtable (R1, R3).
- 9 TV- Debate Civic rights to information and participation in decision making (R1, R3)
- 10 Printing and distributing of information materials (R1, R3)
